








#### How we believe Ireland's Eco-Scheme(s) will interact with Pillar II AECM

Annual v's multi-annual:

> Eco-Scheme action must deliver environmental benefit even if only practiced for one year

 $\geq$  Pillar II action may take longer than one year to achieve environmental benefit

#### Pillar II likely to be targeted with higher requirements.
