


### What are the defining characteristics of an effective LEADER delivery system that can support rural resilience?

networking p flexibility in good latforms Local tools financial communication Development (MAs, NRNs, (handbooks, bringing all & human Strategy LAGs) training...) stakeholders together resources networking for quality clear maximise responsibilities and results "healthy compromise" expert outreach regional strategy networks national/EU strategy ensure enough space for discussion NRNs to communicate that clearly define regional for LAGs LAG is a tool and platform interests (bottom-up for policy implementation approach) vs national at local level transfer ones knowledge and information no limitation of areas from EU level evidence-based (no max size) nor topics (for LAGs and lobbying by LAGs beneficiaries)
