



Rural communities are **diverse**need for LEADER fundingvaries

- 27 LAGs reported more applications due to crisis
- 20 no difference
- 6 less applications

#### Networking brings more value added

- 2014-2020 focus on quality and results
  - Quality management -handbooks
  - Better quality of LDS and better results → more money for LAG
- 2021-2027 focus on quality, results and networking
  - Better networking means better quality and results
  - Dynamic network analysis as a new method to engage stakeholders in LEADER work, preparing and implementing LDS
  - Capacity building for LAGs: Webinars and workshops to help LAGs prepare the dynamic network analysis
  - It is a **learning process** together with the whole delivery chain

#### Elements of success in our LEADER delivery system

### Working together

- All areas covered with LAGs
- Strong support for LEADER by the administration – at the same time respecting the bottom up approach
- Forums and clear practices for dialogue between the administration and LAGs
- NRN facilitates networking, capacity building, exchange and experimenting new ideas
- Trust → stronger network between LAGs - MA - PA & local - regional - national level
