

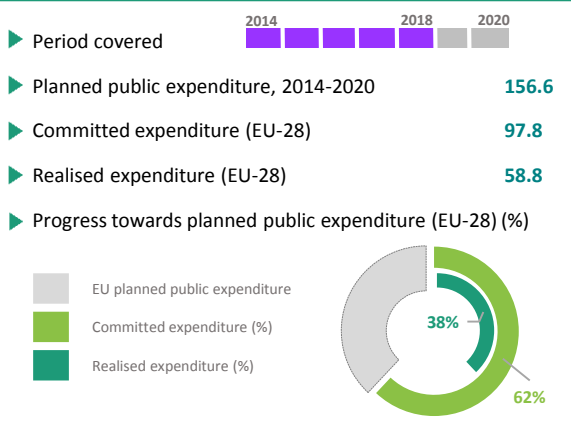

1. Financial expenditure (EU-28)

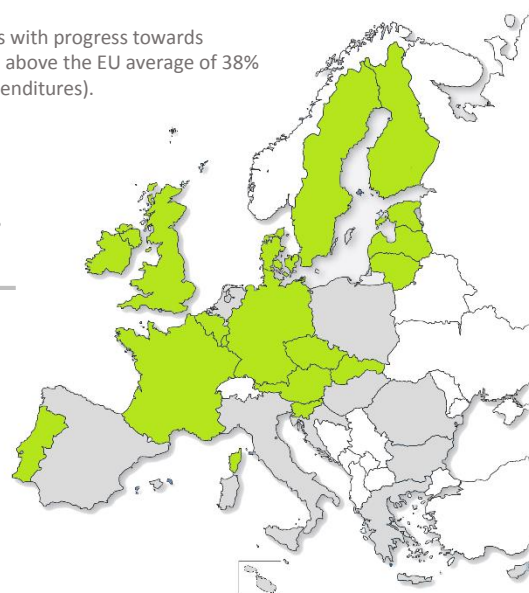
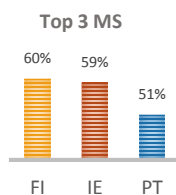

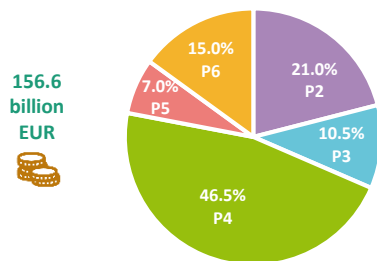


Map 1: Member States with progress towards planned expenditures above the EU average of 38% (based on realised expenditures).



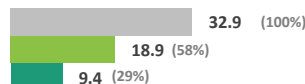

Graph 1: Distribution of EU-28 Total Planned Public Expenditure per Priority (%)²

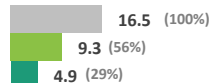


Graph 2: Progress towards planned public expenditures per Priority

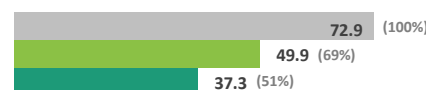
