The future of Agriculture in Spain: A new CAP model aimed at getting results

The proposal on the reform of the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) introduces a profound change in the way in which its instruments will be designed. The CAP will shift the emphasis from compliance and rules towards results and performance.

The Strategic Plan aims to better address the future needs of Spanish agriculture. Thus, Spain wants to implement the Plan from the first moment the post-2020 CAP is launched.






The elaboration of the CAP Plan in Spain

January 2019: Sectoral Conference => Separate working groups for each specific objective:

- ✓ Specific meetings by objective with regional administrations.
- ✓ Specific meetings by objective with stakeholders: farmers associations, environmental organizations, representatives of rural development groups ...
- ✓ General meetings with a larger number of stakeholder representatives (*Partenariado*)





Some specific difficulties for the CAP Plan in Spain

- ❖ A large country, with a strong agricultural sector characterized by multiple sectoral specificities and with two major issues: gender imbalances in the agriculture and rural areas and depopulation.
- The constitutional distribution of competences between regional and national administrations: How to integrate territorial interventions in the CAP Plan?
 - ✓ SWOT: National SWOT with regional specifications when needed
 - ✓ Needs assessment: National needs with regional specific needs
 - ✓ Interventions: National; National with territorial specifications; Regional
