


Role of networks

One of the main tasks of NRNs is:

To provide training and support for LAGs and, in particular, technical assistance for inter-territorial and transnational cooperation.

- MAs also provide support to LAGs
- Other networks, ENRD, ELARD, national LEADER networks are also concerned with supporting cooperation

- Exchange between institutional stakeholders to improve LEADER/CLLD implementation
- Exchange between various ministries to improve the coordination of funds
- · Specific support, guidance and training for LAGs
- · Support for transnational and inter-territorial cooperation





NRN support for cooperation

Collection & dissemination of cooperation ideas:

- Partner-search tools on websites (ENRD tool is being developed – temporary document)
- Idea 🐃 integration with other activities, e.g. thematic groups

Field-trips & cooperation events (seminars, etc.)

- Training & technical assistance

Exchange platforms among different types of stakeholders

- Finland: cooperation (TNC-) table involving rural policy committee, village movement, LAGs, NGOs
- Scotland: cooperation working group involving MA & LAGs

Coordinated cooperation support among Member States

- Nordic-Baltic Network: distributing TNC requests, competition for best LEADER TNC
- UK & Ireland: partner-search tool, common application form, common guidance, etc.
