The ENRD Survey

- Launched in May 2016
- Comprehensive survey (32 Qs)
- To map the LEADER/CLLD cooperation landscape
- To support exchange of information
- To support the development of cooperation fiches
- First phase closed on 3 June (responses from 19 MS/regions)







The ENRD Survey

Procedures (calls, selection)

Eligibility (beneficiaries, actions, costs)

Basic information (RDP, contacts)

Cooperation Survey

Eligibility (territories, partners, themes)

Cooperation (in RDP, in LDS)


Budget, financial information







Cooperation and the LDS









Cooperation guidelines – themes

- Cooperation guidelines published only in 3 MS (4 regions – IT,DE,MT)
- 3 MS/regions specify cooperation themes (PL, RO, IT_Emilia-Romagna)








Eligibility – territories (TNC)

- Rural territories in EU and/or third countries
- Rural and non-rural territories in the EU and rural territories in third countries
- Rural (EU MS) and Nonrural territory (EU MS)
- Rural territory (EU MS) only



Number of RDPs








Eligibility – territories (ITC)

Type of territories eligible for inter-territorial cooperation









Eligibility – cooperation partners (TNC), beneficiaries

- LAGs only (5): BE_Wallonia, DE_Niedersachsen-Bremen, MT, PL, ES_Aragon
- LAGs and group of local public and private partners implementing an LDS in a rural territory (6): SK, AT, LV,SI, DE_Hessen, DE_Rheinland-Pfalz
- LAGs and group of local public and private partners implementing an LDS in a rural or non-rural territory (8): GR, RO, CZ, CY, SE, DE_Sachsen, IT_Emilia-Romagna, IT_Valle D'Aosta
- <u>Eligible beneficiaries:</u> Lags (default) / Other local actors in some RDPs (e.g. SE, AT)







Preparatory support – Eligibility criteria

- 7 RDPs (AT, RO, PL, GR, SE, LV, DE_Sachsen)
- Key criteria
 - Compliance with LDS
 - Existence of a project implementation plan
 - Cooperation partners identified
 - Demonstrable contribution to specific LDS objective(s)








Preparatory support – Eligible actions and costs

Eligible actions

- Meetings, participation at events, feasibility studies are eligible actions in the majority ot RDPs
- Ineligible actions: meetings (2 RDPs), participation at events (5 RDPs), feasibility study (4 RDPs)









Cooperation projects – eligible actions and costs

- Eligible in all RDP responses: Meetings, participation at events, publications, website, joint services and joint products, study visits (in MT joint services and products are not eligible actions)
- Eligible costs options in the majority of Programmes: travel, accommodation, catering, interpreter and translation fees, consulting, telecommunications and postal services, rental of venue, share of common costs for website/publications
- Telecommunications and postal services not eligible in 5 RDPs



Call publication in 2016 (SI, ES_Aragon), in 2017 (LV, RO). BE_Wallonia (every February, September)








Selection of actions

Who selects the following types of actions?










Lead partner

Is a lead partner required for a cooperation project to be eligible?









Funding LEADER/CLLD cooperation

- Maximum amount of support for a cooperation project (total public expenditure, Euro)
 - < 50000 Euro: MT
 - < 100000 Euro: SI, LV, DE_Hessen
 - < 500000 Euro: ES_Aragon, IT_Valle D'Aosta
- Maximum rate of public support
 - 100% e.g. PL, SK, GR, RO
 - 80-90% e.g. AT, SI, BE_Wallonia
 - 25% MT







Funding LEADER/CLLD cooperation

Budget pre-allocation to cooperation (Q28)

Certain proportion of LDS budget (11): e.g. AT, MT, CY, ES_Aragon

Other pre-allocation method (4): e.g. SI – public procurement by MA, SE – LAG decision

Maximum amount of support to preparatory actions (Q29)

Only 4 responses (BE_Wallonia, SI, DE_Hessen, GR)

Ranging from 2700 (BE_wallonia) to 100000 Euro (SI)







The LEADER/CLLD Cooperation fiche

- At least 5 pilot fiches (by July 2016)
- With comprehensive information based on ENRD survey
- Fiche preparation continuous
- Structure based on Survey questions
- Key elements include
 - Basic information
 - Eligible partners and territories
 - Eligible actions and costs
 - Financial information
 - Project selection
